B. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. PARTICIPATION

Denmark, Norway, Finland and Poland will be invited to the Nordic/Polish Championships. The Championships also consists the International Military competition for the invited nations, which may be all the other Nations of the World: Germany, Brazil, etc.

2. PLACE

The Open Nordic/Polish Military Championship in Sailing will take place at the Polish Training Center of Communications and Informatics in Zegrze from 19th of June till 24th of June 2016. The sailing club is located near this Centre and Sailors will have the pleasure to sail on the Zegrze Reservoir, located just north of Warsaw, on the lower course of the Narew river. It is formed by a dam constructed in 1963 with a hydroelectric complex producing 20 Megawatts of energy. Its total area is about 33 km². The name originates from the nearby Zegrze village, featuring the historic Radziwiłł Palace (Pałac Zegrzyński) built in 1847 by the noble Krasiński family.

Due to its attractive location near the Polish capital and natural beauty, Zalew Zegrzyński is a very popular place of recreation for the residents of Warsaw.

3. COMPOSITION OF THE MISSION

The Polish Armed Forces has the pleasure to invite a mission from you country as earlier agreed upon, to participate in the sailing competition.

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Sailors are requested to bring their own sailing gear including life jackets. The type of sailing boats for championship will be Sigma class supplied by the organizer (15 boats). See also Notice of race where you can find detailed information about Championship.

5. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During the stay in Poland the mission will be guest of Training Center of Communications and Informatics in Zegrze. Board, lodging and transportation within this period are at the expenses of the organizer. Extra requirements e.g. telephone, drinks, laundry etc. as well as cost of travel to and from Poland are to be paid by the missions. In accordance with the CISM Regulations only personnel on active duty in the armed forces may participate in the competition. Such personnel must be in possession of a valid military identity card.

OPEN NORDIC/POLISH MILITARY CHAMPIONSHIP IN SAILING 2016 NOTICE OF RACE

1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) will be Training Center of Communications and Informatics in Zegrze.

2 VENUE AND DATES

The venue will be Zegrze, Poland during period 19th June 2016 until 24th June 2016.

3 EVENT FORMAT

Event format will be fleet racing.

4 PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

4.1

(a) Race office is open from 08:00 on the first day of the event and on each racing day from 08:00.

Daily skippers meeting will be held near by racing boats berthing's at 09:00. Race office is located at the Klub Mila Zegrzynek.

(b) Registration of the teams will be at the race office immediately after arrival of the teams.

(c) Practice from 10:00 until 16:00 on days prior to the first racing day.(Monday)

(d) First briefing at 20:00 prior the first racing day in Training Center of Communications and Informatics

(e) First meeting with umpires following the first briefing.

(f) Opening Ceremony at 9:30 on Monday, June 20th.

(g) Racing days from 21st of June till 23rd of June.

(h) Time of the first race will be at 09:00 on the each racing day.

(i) Last attention signal at 17:00 on the 23rd of June.

(j) Daily press conference as announced at the first briefing.

(k) Prize giving at 10:00 on the 24th of June.

4.2 Unless excused by the OA, attendance at the following is mandatory:

(a) Initial briefing for skippers.

(b) Daily briefing for skippers.

(c) Daily press conference for skippers sailing that day.

(d) Prize giving for the skippers and crews.

5 SKIPPERS ELIGIBILITY

(a) A maximum 15 skippers will be invited. Each Nordic/Polish nation can enter minimum 1 crews and maximum 2 crews. Only skippers invited by the OA will be eligible to enter this event.

(b) The registered skipper shall helm the boat at all times while racing, except in an emergency.

(c) All competitors shall obtain an ISAF Sailor ID by registering online at www.Sailing.org/isafsailor.
Skippers shall inform OA of their ISAF Sailor ID until 1st of May 2016.

6 ENTRIES

6.1

(a) The team shall be entered on completion of registration.

6.2 Entry Fee.

There is no entry fee.

6.3 Damage deposit.

There is no damage deposit.

7 RULES

7.1

(a) CISM Sailing Regulations 2012.

(b) General Regulations Governing Nordic/Polish Military Championships 2016.

(c) Regulations governing Nordic/Polish Military Championships 2016.

(d) ISAF RRS,

(e) The rules for the handling of boats will apply, and will also to any practice sailing.

(f) Class rules will not apply.

(g) Any prescriptions of the national authority that will apply will be posted on the official notice board.



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7.2 Major Alternations to the RRS

Add to RRS 41: (e) help to recover from the water and return on board a crew member, provided the return on board is at the approximate location of the recovery.

8 BOATS AND SAILS

- (a) *The event will be sailed in Sigma type of boats.*
- (b) *15 boats will be provided.*
- (c) *The following sails will be provided for each boat: Main Sail, Jib.*
- (d) *Boats will be allocated by draw, either daily or for each round as decided by the Race Committee.*

9 CREW (INCLUDING SKIPPER)

- (a) *The number of crew (including skipper) shall be 3. All registered crew shall sail all races.*
- (b) *No crew weight limit.*
- (c) *When a registered skipper is unable to continue in the event the OA may authorize an original crew member substitute.*
- (d) *When a registered crew member is unable to continue in the event the OA may authorize a substitute, a temporary substitute or other adjustment.*

10 SCORING

- (a) *The scoring system will be low points, system.*
- (b) *3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.*
- (c) *When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score.*
- (d) *When from 4 to 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.*
- (e) *Nordic/Polish Military Team Championship results will be determined by using individual race results. Each Nordic/Polish nation will receive points according nations crew final positions in the individual race among Nordic/Polish nations. Individual race 1st crew will receive 1 pts, 2nd -2 pts, etc. Each Nordic/Polish nations two best crews will be included in this event. Least total points received Nordic/Polish Nation will be the winner.*

11 COURSE

- (a) *The course will be windward/leeward with port rounding's, finishing downwind.*
- (b) *The intended course area will be in front of Sailing Club.*

12 ADVERTISING

- (a) *As boats and equipment will be supplied by the OA, ISAF regulation 20.4 applies. Each boat will be required to display advertising as supplied by the OA.*
- (b) *Boats shall not be permitted the right to protest for breaches of any rules regarding advertising (amends RRS 60.1)*

13 PRIZES

- (a) *There will be prizes for the Open Individual Race, Nordic/Polish Individual Race and Nordic/Polish Team Championship (based on the results of the individual race see 10 (e))*

14 MEDIA, IMAGES AND SOUND

14.1 If requires by the OA:

- (a) *Television personnel and equipment (or dummies) supplied by the OA shall be carries on board while racing.*
- (b) *Competitors shall wear microphones supplied by the OA during racing and be available for interviews when advised by the OA or RC.*
- (c) *Registered skippers shall wear communications equipment supplied by the OA that will allow commentators to communicate with them whilst racing.*

14.2 *Competitors shall not interfere with the normal working of the OA supplied media equipment.*

14.3 *The OA have the right to use images and sound recorded during the event free of any charge.*



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15 COACH BOATS

- (a) *Coach boats shall conspicuously display identification (national flag) of the team being coached. A coach boat is any boat that is under the direction or control of a person gathering information or giving material support for the benefit of particular competitors either on the water or off.*
- (b) *Any interference by a coach boat with the racing or event organization may result in a penalty applied to appropriate skipper or team, at the discretion of the protest committee.*

16 OTHER REQUIREMENTS

It is recommended that each team wears distinctive team clothing.

17 DISCLAIMER

All those taking part in the event do so at their own risk. The OA, its associates and appointees accept no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or inconvenience incurred, howsoever caused.

18 INVITATIONS

Entries will only be accepted from invited skippers representing invited nations.
