E. Conditions of Stay

- Board, lodging and medical care will be at the expenses of the organizers.
- Participants who ask for services not covered by the Organizers, such as telephone calls, drinks, laundry etc. must pay the respective extra expenses.
- Additional people will not be accepted without official written permission of the Organizers.

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F. Regulations of the Championship

- The Regional Military Biathlon Championships Regulations, read and in conjunction with International Biathlon Union (IBU) rules and regulations, the currently valid CISM Regulations, as well as local rules discussed during the Preliminary and Technical Meeting will apply.
- The Competition is limited to military personal on active duty (see CISM Regulations, art.7.21).
- Each delegation may enter a maximum of four (4) athletes per individual event and one (1) team in each relay.
- There will be carried out Team Competition which will be calculated based on three best results from Sprint Competitions in Men and Women.

G. Uniforms

Service uniform (field dress) is required for the Opening Ceremony, the Closing Ceremony and all other official occasions.

Chiefs of Mission in full service uniforms.

Permission to wear uniform is granted.

Each participating nation shall provide one national flag (1.5 x 2.5m) and their national anthem on CD.

H. Anti-Doping

- Anti-Doping tests will be organized in accordance with the CISM Anti-Doping Regulations
- o Chapter IX.
- The number of tests shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission
- established during the Preliminary Meeting, according to the CISM Regulations.
- The tests will be performed according to the latest WADA Anti-Doping Code and
- Procedures.

I. Customs and Visa Procedures

Information concerning passport, visa and vaccination can be obtained from the Polish Embassy in your country.

Every Team Member is obligated to enter Passport Number in Final Entry (Annex 2a/b), which has to be sent to organizer to 28th February 2019.
