PROGRAM & GENERAL INFORMATION

1. PARTICIPATION

Nordic countries: Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden are allowed to participate with up to two teams of athletes (2x4 women and 2x6 men) and maximum 4 officials, in total 24 persons per nation.

Other countries: Austria, Germany, The Netherlands and Poland are allowed to participate with up to two teams of athletes (1x4 women and 1x6 men) and 4 officials, in total 14 persons per nation.

All countries are allowed to participate with up to 4 para-athletes, male or female with mental and/or physical disabilities and 1 coach/carer.

The total numbers of athletes are estimated to maximum approx.192 pax.

2. REGULATIONS

The championship will be governed by the following regulations:

- CISM Military Pentathlon Regulations, Edition 2015.
- General Regulations governing the Nordic Military Championships (draft of 2016).
- The regulations for the Nordic Military Championship in Military Pentathlon, 2015.
- A regulation for Para-athletes participation is to be decided on behalf of the nation's informal agreements.

Note: Specific regulations concerning para-athletes are to be decided.

In accordance with Article 3.19 of the CISM regulations, all competitors must be active service personnel although participating para-athletes can be active and/or former service personnel.

3. ORGANIZERS AND TRANSPORT

The championship will be hosted and organized by the Danish Army Engineer Regiment and Skive Garrison in Skive located in the middle of Jutland, which is the western part of Denmark.

The missions are expected to meet the travel expenses to and from Denmark. The organizer will arrange local transportation in Denmark if necessary. Missions are allowed to go by vehicle and arrive directly at the barracks in Skive. If going by plane the participating missions are advised to arrive at the airport of Karup. From Karup Airport the organizer will arrange transportation to and from Skive.

4. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During your stay in Denmark the missions will be guests of the Danish Armed Forces from June 19th to 23rd 2016 all though *it will be possible to arrive on June 18th 2016* in order to take part in the practice program on June 19th 2016.

Normal board and lodging is at the expense of the organizer. All mission members are accommodated in the barracks of Skive Garrison. Extra members are requested to book hotel rooms in Skive City.

Expenses including telephone, laundry, drinks etc. must be paid by the consumers.

5. SPORT FACILITIES

Shooting will be carried out at the Dalgas Shooting Centre with 20 targets and electronic scoring system. The Shooting Centre is located app. 15 kilometres from Skive Garrison.

Obstacle swimming will be conducted in Skive Swimming Centre, 50 meter indoor-swimming-pool, located app. 1 kilometre from Skive Garrison.

All other disciplines will take place in the immediate vicinity of Skive Garrison. Grenades for the throwing competition will be provided by the organizer.

In order to reduce the number of officials from organizer participants must foresee to be involved as officials. A special process chart will be set up. Detailed information will be discussed during the technical meeting. This decision has been made at Nordic Sport Leaders Meeting.

6. WEATHER CONDITIONS

The average weather condition in June in Skive:

- Temperature: +15 + 25° C.
- Rain showers are possible.

7. PASSPORTS, VISAS, UNIFORM

For information on passport and visas for entry into Denmark, please contact the Danish Embassy in your country. The participating missions are permitted and obliged to wear uniform during their stay and on scheduled occasions.
