# Neighbours proposals 2016



## CISM regulations, Art 2.7. (to delete)

“The President may have at his disposal a staff supported by CISM provided the General Assembly approves the budget associated with these expenses.”

Explanation: There is no need for an additional staff as long as there is a functional CISM HQ in the organization.



# Neighbours proposals 2016



## CISM regulations, Art 4.8. A/D/F (to adapt)

- Actual A.** Be a delegate for at least one (1) year  
**Proposal: A.** Have CISM experience for at least one (1) year  
**Remark:** What could be specified is the “CISM experience”. Is it necessary, to serve or be listed as a delegate or chief of mission or is the numerous activity as a chief of mission over a longer period also sufficient?
- Actual D.** Be fluent in English and French  
**Proposal D.** Be fluent in English and knowledge of French language is recommended
- Actual F.** Possess a good knowledge of sport management  
**Explanation:** Those criteria should be measurable.  
**Remark:** According to the regulations, the BoD selects its candidate and present him/her to the GA. If there is more than one candidate, the BoD executes a selection process to find out the better one by an interview, a kind of assessment, ...  
So these criteria are measured and considered.



# Neighbours proposals 2016



## CISM regulation, Art 2.5. (reduce the number of BoD members from 19 to 15)

Neighbours propose reducing of the size of the BoD (from 19 to 15). The fifteen (15) seats on the BoD are divided between the four continents to ensure geographic balance as follows. Africa 4, America 3, Asia 3 and Europe 4, including the Vice Presidents.

The fifteenth seat is for the CISM President who represents the whole organization.

Explanation: Size of the BoD is too large to be operational, whereas the participation in BoD meetings varies.
