E. THE EXECUTION OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament was held as part of an international civilian tournament, in total 12 teams from all over Europe. The three military teams had an intern CISM competition as part of



the larger tournament. This solution was a success as the CISM teams played more games against different teams as well as also competing against the other military teams.

The structure of the tournament also meant that the military Para-sport society and the civilian Para-sport society had the opportunity to work closely together and learn from each other.

The tournament was conducted professionally and to the highest standard with international world class judges. The tournament was executed with great success.

F. FINANCIALS

The invited nations paid the expenses for the transportation to the host nation (Denmark).

The total cost of the event for the host nation has been approximately 14.000 Euro.

G. Final Comments

It is the hope of the Danish Delegation to CISM that other nations find inspiration in our CISM Regional Para SIT CUP and that other nations in the future will follow up with other CISM Para-sport tournaments. It is important that rules are composed to allow veterans with military injuries to participate. Thus sometimes civilian para-rules are too restrictive, not allowing all physically and mentally disabled veterans.
