4. Access to the location of the competition

The location of the competition is the military base of The Netherlands Armed Forces in Schaarsbergen and the shooting range Heumensoord in Nijmegen. Travelling expenses, to and from The Netherlands, the barracks location and between barracks location and shooting range will be the responsibility of the participating country.

4.1 Barracks

All weapons and ammunition will be at the responsibility of the participating teams. At the Oranjekazerne barracks, a weapon storage facility is available.

4.2 Shooting range

Shooting ranges in Kamp Heumensoord, Nijmegen. This place is only accessible by road.

The location of the shooting range is at the end of the Beukenlaan which is a side road of the Scheidingsweg.

When possible a weapon mechanic for Walter GSP weapons will be present on site.

Electronic targets, SIUS-Ascor will be used, without shadow targets.

5. Conditions of stay

During their stay in The Netherlands the missions will be guests of The Netherlands Armed Forces from September 19th to September 22nd, 2017.

Board and lodging will be provided by the organizing committee and is free of charge.

Mission members will be accommodated in barracks.

Additional food & beverage and special requirements (telephone, laundry, etc.) must be paid by the concerning mission.

There is no way to provide official accommodation prior to and after the invitation dates. Any costs, made before the date of arrival and/or after the date of departure, must be covered by the participants.

However the informal diner Sept 20th is at own expenses. For those who do not participate in this diner, diner can be used at the barracks.

Missions who also participate in the Cramer Revolver match will be provided the same facilities as mentioned at **4.1** and as stated in the program.

6. Food and beverage

Menus are widely varied.

7. Medical support

The Netherlands Armed Forces will take care of medical support (first aid) on site. Further costs for medical support are at the expense of the participants. Participants' health insurance must be valid in the Netherlands and a copy must be handed over if applicable.

8. Regulations of the championship

The championship will be governed by the CISM Regulations. (Latest Edition). Specific regulations for this championship will be forwarded to all participating countries during the Technical Meeting.

9. Uniforms / mandatory equipment

No service uniforms are required.

10. Customs and visa procedures

For information regarding passport and visas for entry into The Netherlands, please contact The Netherlands embassy in your country or the respective embassy serving your country in The Netherlands.

Make sure, that you apply for your visa in time!

11. Weather conditions

The temperature in September in The Netherlands is between 15°C – 23°C. Average temperature is about 20° C. The probability for rain is at 35%.
