

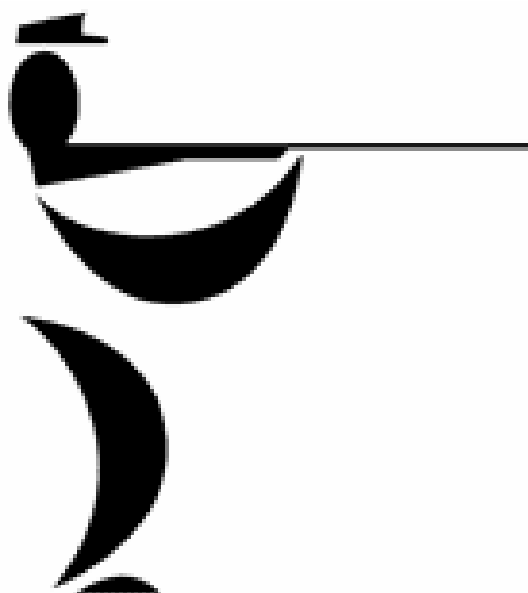

2. COMPOSITION OF THE MISSION

- Team Captain: 1
- Coach: 1
- Competitors: **6 (male)**
- Total: **8**
- Only personnel on active duty in the Armed Forces may participate in this CISM Para Shooting Cup. Such personnel must be in possession of a valid military identity card. (see Para-shooting Competition Regulations. art 2.1).
- **There is no possibility to lodge additional persons!**

3. ACCESS TO THE LOCATION OF THE COMPETITION

- Costs of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating country.
- The German Armed Forces will ensure the transportation from the place of arrival in the host country to the place of stay and also the transport during the competitions.
- by aircraft: **Munich Airport or Penzing Military Airport**
- by train: **Railway Station Sonthofen**
- by bus or car: **Sportfördergruppe der Bundeswehr, Salzweg 24, D-87527 Sonthofen**

4. CONDITIONS OF STAY

- During their stay in Sonthofen from 18th to 22nd June 2018 the competitors and officials are guests of the German Armed Forces. Suitable accommodation, messing and local transportation will be provided by the organizer. Extra expenses such as fees for telephone calls, laundry services, additional drinks, etc. must be paid by the consumer.
- Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of the German Federal Armed Forces. Routine medical care will be the responsibility of the missions. The German Federal Armed Forces will provide doctors for all scheduled competitions. The German Federal Armed Forces will not be responsible for any advanced medical expenses, including hospital stays, surgical procedures, and/or other medical care beyond first aid. All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage. Participants are also responsible for ensuring they have with them any specific medication or medical supplies required for the event as will be well.

5. REGULATIONS OF THE COMPETITION

- The CISM Para Shooting Rifle Cup will be staged in accordance with the IPC Shooting Regulations.
- Please note that only athletes with **handicap SH1 and SH2** are allowed to participate. The shooting **discipline** will be **R4, R5, R9, P1, P2 and P4**. Athletes handicapped with a wheelchair could not participate, because we will not be able to accommodate them.

6. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES

- For information regarding passport and visas for entry into Germany, please contact the German Embassy in your country or the respective embassy serving your country (Not later than 3 weeks before leaving!).
- The entry by military/civilian members of foreign armed forces into the territory of the Federal Republic of Germany and their transit through it are subject to approval and **requests for permission** (Annex 3) must be submitted in writing by the military attaché to FMOD - **not later than 20 working days** prior the intended date of entry.
- **According to the Weapons Control Act, it is also necessary to register all weapons and ammunition in Annex 3 which you will bring to Germany.**

7. UNIFORMS

- Military service uniforms are required for the official ceremonies.
- Competition: Outfit and equipment in accordance with International Sport Shooting Federation (ISSF) Rules (Edition 2018) and the IPC Shooting Regulations.

8. TRANSPORTATION

- The costs of travel to the point of arrival in Germany will be charged to each mission as well as the costs of travel from the point of departure back home. The organizer will provide local transport from the points of arrival in Germany (Sonthofen) and back to them.

9. WEATHER CONDITIONS

- The weather in end of June can range from a daily high temperature from +17°C to +25°C, and a daily low temperature from +7°C to +11°C, with an average of +16°C.
- There might be rain showers, and occasionally it can rain during a whole day.
- Thunder and lightning might occur.

FINAL ENTRY – Commitment by the Chief of Mission

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the Article 3.28. of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

A) Chief of Mission

1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B) Conduct of a mission

1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behaviour of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behaviour and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorised to take part in the Championship.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.

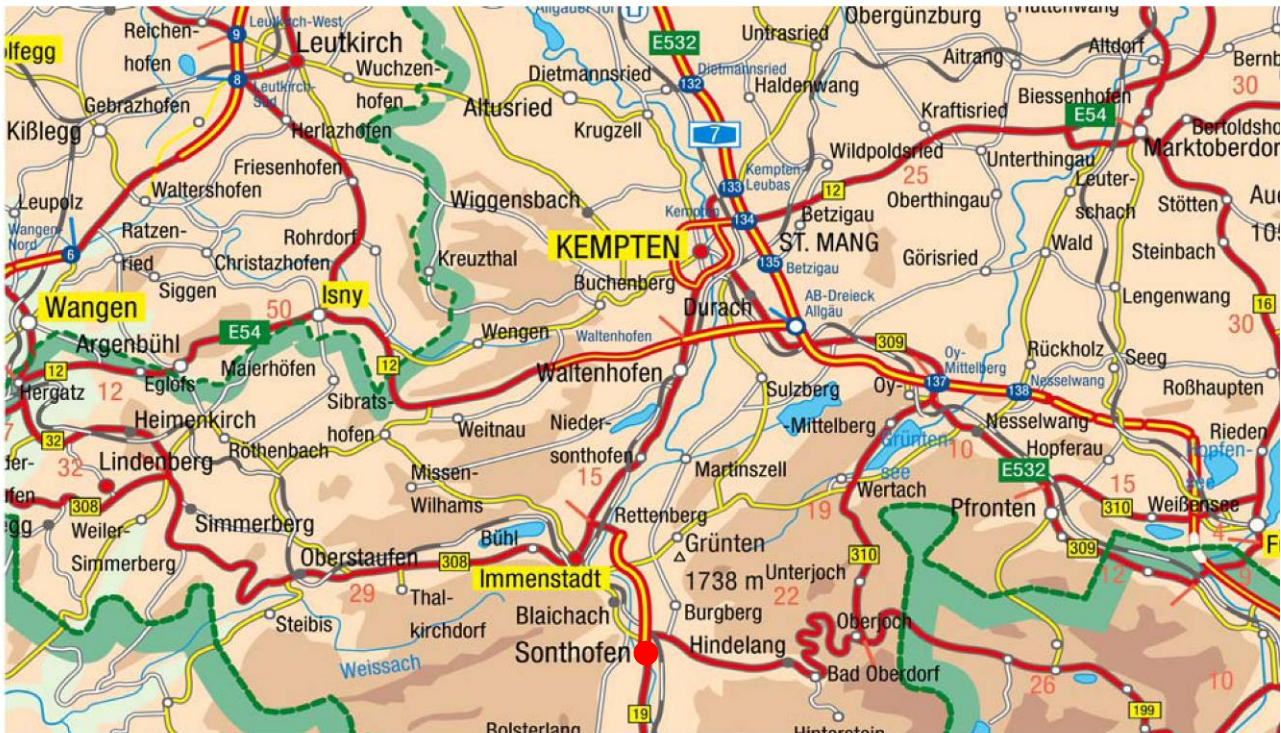
