Please, be aware only 13 teams (including Poland) can participate in this championship. The first countries to register will be our guest!! According to the CISM Regulations (see CISM Police Manual, art. 3.19) only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competition.

D. Access to the Location of the Competition.

- The travel cost to the host country and respective return will occur under the responsibility of the participating country.
- The organizer will ensure the transportation from the place of arrival (Points of arrival) in the host country to the place of stay and the transport during the competitions as well.

- Competition will be conducted on the basis of CISM Parachuting Regulations (Edition 2019) only accuracy landing.
- Additional regulations will be shown and explained at the Preliminary Meeting.
- During the Tournament gift exchange will be held.

G. Uniforms.

- Military uniform is required for the Opening and Closing Ceremony and all other official occasions.
- Permission to wear uniform is granted.




