3. Composition of the Delegation.

1 Chief of the delegation

1 Coach

1 Ad Libitum

12 players (Men)

15 Totals

- Only active military personnel may participate in the competition.
- Additional delegation members will not be accepted by the organizer.

4. Transport.

All participants arriving to Bosnia and Herzegovina will be welcomed at the Sarajevo international airport or the Sarajevo railway station by the Organizing Committee and transported to the Rajlovac barracks. Participants arriving by car can drive directly to Rajlovac barracks. Organizer cannot provide transportation from any other points of arrival. The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating country.

Note:

- . If you plan to use car with military registration numbers and tactical insignias, arrangements for movement through country has to be made through the official diplomatic channels (Military attaché).
- . The cost of travel to and back from Bosnia and Herzegovina will be responsibility of the country participating in the event.
- . Armed forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina's Delegation to CISM will ensure transportation from the place of entry/arrival (for those coming by train, bus or airplane) to place of accommodation and also during the competition.

5. Accommodation

During stay in Bosnia and Herzegovina, delegations will be guests of the Armed Forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina from 07th to 12th June 2020. Full board and lodging are at the expense of the organizer. Accommodation will be provided at the Military barracks “Rajlovac” in Sarajevo. Extra expenses including: telephone, laundry and drinks will be paid by the consumers. Additional persons will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizer.

Emergency medical service for the participants will be provided by the organizer throughout the event.

6. Regulations of the Championship.

The events will be governed by CISM and FIFA regulations.

The Futsal competitions shall be subject to the Futsal Rules and Regulations of the FIFA (Futsal Laws of the Game 2014/2015 - available at: <http://www.fifa.com>), and the English text will be binding.

6.1 Organization

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for the Futsal competitions of the 12. CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020. The opening and closing ceremony will be organized according to CISM Procedure Manual, Article 3.26, Ceremonies and Protocol.

6.2 Venues and times

- a. The Organizing Committee will determine the venues and times of the Futsal competitions and the teams will be notified accordingly.
- b. The Organizing Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions. These decisions will be final.

6.3 Equipment

The Participating Delegations will comply with the FIFA Equipment Regulations in force. Participating Delegations are not allowed to display political, religious, commercial or personal messages in any language or form on their playing or team kits, equipment, or body during the time spent in the halls or any other areas where accreditation is required to gain access.

The futsal balls for the 12. CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020, will be selected by the Organizing Committee, according to FIFA regulations. Each team will receive two (2) match balls for training purposes.

For matches, each participating delegation must bring at least two team uniform sets of different colors.

6.4 Disciplinary matters

- a. Disciplinary incidents will be dealt in compliance with CISM Policy Manual - 2008, Article 1.11, Sanctions.

b. The Participating Delegations and their players agree to comply with the CISM's statutes and regulations; FIFA's Futsal Laws of the Games, the WADA's doping regulations, the equipment regulations and the commercial regulations. Likewise, they agree to comply with all further CISM and FIFA guidelines, circulars, directives and decisions that apply to the 12 CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020.

c. The players agree notably to:

- respect the spirit of fair play and non-violence
- behave accordingly to the fact that they are ambassadors of the armed forces from their respective countries
- refrain from doping as defined by the WADA Doping Control Regulations

Players sent off the field under penalty will automatically be suspended as follows:

- a. Serious foul play - the next game.
- b. Violent conduct - the next 2 games.
- c. Spitting at an opponent or any other person - the next 2 games.
- d. Denying the opposition a goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball - the next 1 game.
- e. Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick - the next game.
- f. Using offensive or insulting or abusive language and/or gestures - the next 2 games.
- g. Receiving a second caution in the same match - the next game.
- h. A player who is reported by the referee for misconduct after the match - the next 2 games.

A player who has been sent off must leave the vicinity of the field of play and the technical area.

6.5 Protests

a. For the purpose of these regulations, protests are objections of any kind related to events or matters that have a direct effect on matches, including but not limited to the state of and markings on the pitch, accessory match equipment, eligibility of players, venue installations and futsal balls.

b. Unless otherwise stipulated in this article, protests shall be submitted in writing to the Technical Jury within two (2) hours of conclusion of the match in question and followed up immediately with a full written report, including a copy of the original protest, to the Bosnian Delegation to CISM, otherwise they will be disregarded.

c. Protests regarding the eligibility of players nominated for matches shall be submitted in writing to Organizing Committee no later than two (2) hours before the first match of the 12. CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020.

d. Protests regarding the state of the pitch, its surroundings, markings or accessory items (e.g. goals or futsal balls) shall be made in writing to the referee before the start of the match by the head of delegation of the team lodging the protest. If the state of the pitch becomes unplayable during a match, the captain of the protesting team shall immediately lodge a protest with the referee in the presence of the captain of the opposing team. The protest shall then be confirmed in writing to the President of the Technical Jury, by the head of delegation no later than two (2) hours after the match.

6.6 System of competition

Competitions of 12. CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020 will be realized as follows:

a. The 6 teams will be divided into 2 groups:

– The competitions between groups will be played on a league basis of a single round robin.
– A maximum of two matches per day will be allowed, with a minimum interval of 1 hour between them.

– The winner of each game will be awarded two points, the loser no points and in case of a draw, each team will be awarded one point.

– Ranking shall be determined as follows:

- 1) Greater number of points obtained;
- 2) Goal difference in all matches;
- 3) Greater number of goals scored in all matches;

– If two or more teams are equal on the basis of the above three criteria, their place shall be determined as follows:

- 1) Greater number of points obtained in the matches between the team concerned
- 2) Goal difference resulting from the matches between the teams concerned;
- 3) Greater number of goals scored in the matches between the teams concerned;
- 4) Drawing lots by the Organizing Committee.

b. The semi-final games will be played on the Cross system, i.e., the team placed first in Group A will play against the team placed second in Group B and the team placed second in Group A will play against the team placed first in Group B.

d. The two winning teams in the semi-finals will play in the final game for 1st and 2nd places, and the two losing teams in the semi-finals will play for 3rd and 4th places.

e. The teams placed 3rd in each group will play on the same system for places 5 and 6.

6.9 Duration of game

- a. Each game will last 40 minutes - two periods of 20 minutes with a break of 10 minutes.
- b. In the final stage (Semi-finals and Final), if after 40 minutes a game will end in a draw, extra time - 2 periods of 5 minutes (net.) each - will be added. A break of 5 minutes will be given after the 40 minutes, but not between the two periods of the extra time.
- c. If after the extra time the draw still exists, the winner of the game will be decided by a free kick competition from a 6 meters mark. Each team will take five kicks alternately. The team to kick first will be decided by a draw.
- d. If both teams scored the same number of goals after 5 free kicks each, the free kicks will continue until such a time that both teams have kicked the same number of kicks and one team scored a goal more than the other.
- e. Only players who were on the field of play at the end of the extra time are allowed to take part in the first five free kicks each kick will be taken by a different player. If the game is still undecided the rest of the players in the list will take part in the competition as well. A player will be allowed to kick a second time only after all the players in his team, including the goal keeper, have taken their kicks.
- f. Each player, who was actually playing the game when it ended, including the extra time, is allowed to replace the goalkeeper when penalty kicks are taken.

6.10 Referees

The Organizing Committee will select a Referees' Committee, which in turn will appoint the referees of the competition.

6.10 General

- a. These regulations are but one part of the complete, and the 12. CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020 must be read along with the instructions found in "Basic Rules and Regulations and Disciplinary Procedures".
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the Regulations written here and those appearing in the "Basic Rules and Regulations", the regulations written here will apply and be binding.

The Organizer Committee of the 12. CISM Futsal Cup for Peace 2020 will provide medals and cups for top three teams.

7. Anti-doping.

Anti Doping tests will be organized in accordance with the CISM anti-doping regulations - Policy Manual - Chapter IV.

The number of tests shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission established during the Preliminary meeting, according to the CISM Regulations.

The tests will be performed according to the latest WADA Anti Doping Code and Procedures

8. Uniforms.

Uniform - service dress uniform at opening and closing ceremony and other official functions.

Training clothes - during competition

Leisure - during free time

9. Customs and Visa procedures.

For information on passports and visas for entry into Bosnia and Herzegovina, please contact the Bosnia and Herzegovina Embassy in your country.

10. Weather Conditions.

The average temperatures in Bosnia and Herzegovina at this time are between 13 to 18 (night) and 28 to 32 degrees Celsius (during the day).

FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE HEAD OF DELEGATION

NATION:

The undersigned, Chief of Delegation declare that he has read the Article 3.28. of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

A. Head of Delegation

1. Heads of Delegations shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Delegations must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in press conferences on CISM, cultural days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

B. Conduct of a Delegation

1. The Head of Delegation is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports activities as well as in general. He shall ensure that members of his delegation respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Head of Delegation shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his delegation, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other delegations, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The delegation, that does not wear military uniforms during the opening ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorized to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the delegation from further competition.
