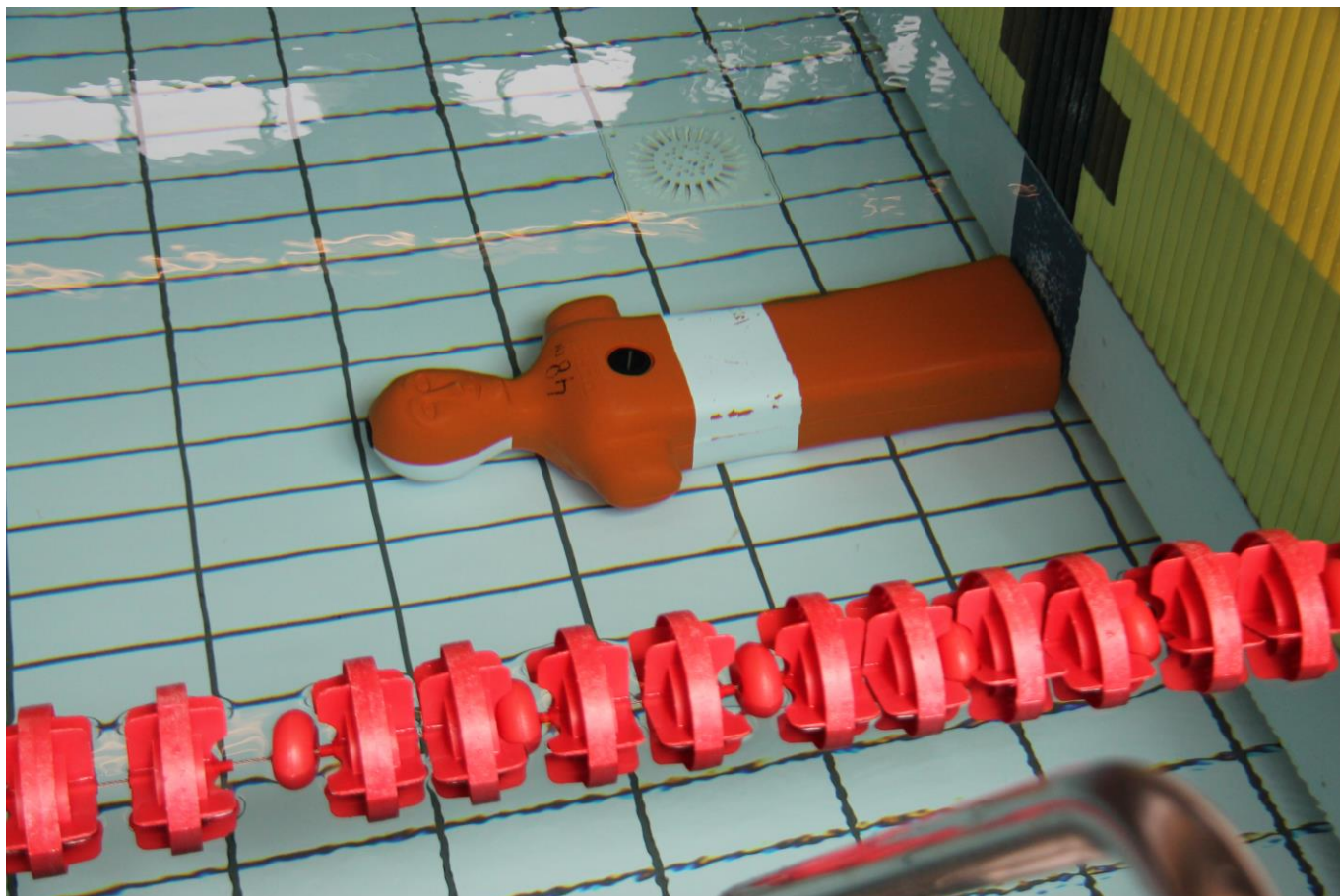

2. Right to participate in the 11th World Military Lifesaving Championship

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 11th World Military Lifesaving Championship from July 6th until July 14th, 2020 in the Netherlands. An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

4. Composition of the mission

*Missions can only bring 1 coach if there are less than 10 athletes. Two coaches are permitted only if the mission has 10 or more athletes in attendance.

**Only for the countries that have approved members on the CISM Sport Committee (CSC) Swimming. CSC members are not included in maximum number of participants. The CSC members are the only personnel permitted to arrive 2 days earlier to oversee/coordinate the final preparations prior to the commencement of the competition.

***Each country has the possibility to bring in 1 referee, it's not mandatory.

According to the CISM Regulations, Edition July 2019, Article 7.21, item A and item D only military personnel in active duty and in possession of a valid military ID card may participate in the competition.

Additional visitors will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizing committee. The costs for board and lodging are at their own expenses.

5. Access to the location of the competition

The location of the competition is the Marine Establishment Amsterdam (MEA) Barracks of The Netherlands Armed Forces in Amsterdam. Travelling expenses, to and from The Netherlands, will be the responsibility of the participating country.

The organizing committee will provide round-trip transportation from the place of arrival to the place of stay in The Netherlands and the transport during the competition.

6. Conditions of stay

During their stay in The Netherlands the missions will be guests of The Netherlands Armed Forces from July 6th to July 14th 2020.

Board and lodging will be provided by the organizing committee and is free of charge. Mission members will be accommodated in barracks. **In the accommodation towels and soap will not be provided by the organization.**

Additional food & beverage and special requirements (telephone, laundry, etc.) must be paid by the concerning mission.

There is no way to provide official accommodation prior to and after the invitation dates. Any costs, made before the date of arrival and/or after the date of departure, must be covered by the participants.

7. Food and beverage

The use of bottled water is not necessary. Tap water is safe to drink.
Menus are widely varied.

8. Medical support

The Netherlands will take care of medical support (first aid) on site. Further costs for medical support are at the expense of the participants. Participants health insurance must be valid in The Netherlands and a copy must be handed over if applicable.

9. Regulations of the championship

The championship will be governed by the CISM Regulations (Edition July 2019) the CISM Lifesaving Regulations (Edition 2016), the current ILS Regulations and CISM anti-doping Regulations.

10. Anti-doping

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.

The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).

In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

Service uniform is mandatory for the opening- and closing ceremony.

13. Weather conditions and additional information

1. The temperature in July in The Netherlands is between 20°C – 30°C. Average temperature is about 23° C. Average water temperature is 16° C. The probability for rain is at 60%.
2. The currency used in The Netherlands is the EURO.
3. The location of the Pool competition will be the Swimming centre of Rotterdam. The location of the beach competition will be the beach of IJmuiden.
4. The distance from Amsterdam to Rotterdam will be 86 km and from Amsterdam to IJmuiden will be 45 km.
