A. Right to participate in the 53th World Military Shooting Championship (SHOTGUN)-2021

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 53th World Military Shooting Championship (SHOTGUN)-2021
An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championship for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

D. Accreditation Cards.

- The accreditation cards of 53th World Military Shooting Championship (Shotgun)-2021 are the official identification documents issued and will authorize card holders with access to specific competition venues and zones.

E. Security

- All mission members shall abide by the laws of The Islamic Republic of Pakistan during their stay in Pakistan and are to cooperate with the management to ensure the security for all during 53th World Military Shooting Championship (SHOTGUN)-2021.
- In case of an individual violating any law or regulation, the respective Chief of Mission (CoM) and personnel involved are required to cooperate with concerned committee for the investigation.
- CoM, Pakistan will promptly report the situation to CISM HQ and mission concerned.

F. Access to the Location of the Competition.

- International / domestic flights operate from / to Allama Iqbal International Airport; Lahore; Provincial capital of Punjab Province of Pakistan. Lahore is at 4 hours drive (By road) and 40 minutes (By Air) from Islamabad (Capital) of Pakistan.
- Venue of the event is about 5 Km from Allama Iqbal International Airport.
- The travel cost to the host country and respective return will occur under the responsibility of the participating country.
- The organizer will ensure the transportation from the place of arrival in the host country to the place of stay and the transport during the competitions as well.

G. Conditions of Stay

- During stay at LAHORE, the missions will be guests of the Pakistan Armed Forces from 1 to 10 October 2021.
- Organizer cannot host earlier arrivals or late departures.
- Normal boarding and lodging is at the expense of the organizers (for the participants mentioned in C only).
- Special requirements and additional services are to be paid by the participants.
- Expenditures involved in travelling from parent country to port of arrival (POA) at Pakistan is the responsibility of participating country.
- The Host country will provide local transportation from the Airport to the hotel and for all official events / activities during the Championship.
- The organizer will take care of first aid medical support at the competition site. Further costs incurred for medical care (hospitalizations, surgical operations or special treatments, repatriation in case of illness or accidents) are to be borne by the participants.



H. Regulations of the Championship.

- According to the CISM Regulations (see Article 7.23), only Military personnel on active duty and holders of a valid military ID card may take part in the competition.
- Original military ID card is requested; copies, written declarations or certificates will not be accepted.
- Additional visitors will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizing committee. In any case, the costs for boarding and lodging are at their own expenses.
- The competition will be conducted under the provision of CISM Sport Regulation Shooting (Article 5.5) draft edition 2018 and ISSF Shooting Regulations.

I. Ammunition and Target.

- Will be available at Shooting Range for practice and matches at following rates:-
 - a. 1 x Box of Ammunition (25 x Cartridges) - 16 US \$
 - b. Clay Targets (25 x Targets) - 10 US \$

J. Anti-doping

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).
- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

K. Uniforms.

- The participating missions are obliged to wear uniform (summer dress) during official scheduled events, such as the opening and closing ceremonies.
- Sport attire marked with country name may be worn outside ceremonial events.
- The delegations are requested to bring one national flag and the Chief of delegation are requested to check if their respective national anthem, available on the CISM Extranet (<http://members.milспорт.one/officialdocuments/protocol-events-guidelines>), is up to date and can be used in sports competitions.



L. Customs and Visa Procedures.

- For information regarding passport and visas to enter Pakistan, please contact the Pakistan Embassy in your country or the respective Embassy serving your country in Pakistan.
- Chief of Delegations (members countries) are requested to complete weapons and ammunition Annex-4 and submit the same to host nation by due date. Temporary import permit for weapons and ammunition will be issued against each athlete for duration of competition.

M. Weather Conditions

- In early October temperature can range from 22 to 33 degree Celsius. Weather is generally pleasant and dry with good visibility.

N. Registration Forms Deadlines.

- **Preliminary Agreement (Annex-1) Not Later Than: 30/06/2021.**
- Final Entry – Composition of the Mission (Annex-2a), Final Entry - Commitment by the Chief of Mission (Annex-2b), Final Entry – Travel Data (Annex-3), and Final Entry – Weapons and Ammunition (Annex-4): Not Later Than: **30/07/2021.**

O. COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND PREVENTIONS.

1. Following guidelines are hereby issued as precautionary measures against COVID-19 precautions:-
 - a. Pre-travelling health checks for all participants should be held to ensure the exclusion of those with potential risks.
 - b. All Athletes / Officials must be in possession of COVID-19 (negative) report not older than 72 hours before entering Pakistan.
 - c. 72 Hours PCR test is mandatory and will be requested by authorities of host country on the arrival at Lahore. However, a pre-event medical test for COVID-19 may be mandatory on the arrival at the hotel.
 - d. Post arrival checks at Airport will be conducted by CISM Pakistan and in case of a positive test, the person will not be allowed to participate in Championship.
 - e. **CISM Pakistan will send a COVID update one week before Final Entry (FE) expiring dates.**
 - f. Temperature Checks will be done for accessing the different events



and no access will be allowed to anyone with high temperature or symptoms of COVID.

- g. Mandatory face mask usage, except during Matches.
- h. Due to COVID restrictions, Opening and Closing Ceremonies will be at reduced scale and adapted to the COVID Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).
- i. In case of symptoms suggestive of acute respiratory illness before, during or after travel, the individuals are encouraged to seek medical attention and share travel history with CISM Pakistan.
- j. Individual Responsibility:
 - (1) Participants should aim to keep at least two meters of distance from other people.
 - (2) Avoid handshakes.
 - (3) Frequent hand washing with soap / use of alcohol-based (at least 65-70%) sanitizer to be ensured.
 - (4) Avoid steam rooms or sauna.
