According to CISM Regulations, Edition July 2017, Article 7.21, item A and item D only military personnel on active duty and in possession of a valid military ID card may participate in the competition. All competitors need to be in possession of a license from their respective national cycling federation.

As per CISM GA Decision, para-athletes are not beholden to the obligation of being currently active-duty personnel.

Additional visitors will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizing committee. The costs for board and lodging are at their own expenses.

4. Location Access

Accommodation for the participants of the championships will be located at the Quartier Coiffé 79400 Saint-Maixent l'Ecole France. Travelling expenses, to and from France, are under the responsibility of the participating country.

5. Conditions of Stay

During their stay in France, missions will be guests of the French Armed Forces from the 24th August to the 28th August 28th 2021.

Board and lodging will be provided by the organizing committee free of charge.

Mission members will be accommodated in barracks. Towels and soap will not be provided by the organization.

Additional food & beverage and special requirements (telephone, laundry, etc.) must be paid by the concerned mission.

There is no way to provide official accommodation prior to and after the championship dates. Any costs incurred before the date of arrival and/or after the date of departure, must be covered by the participants.

6. Billeting

The use of bottled water is not necessary. Tap water is safe to drink.

Menus are varied.

7. Medical Support

France will take care of medical support (first aid) on site. Further costs for medical support are at the expense of the participants. Participants health insurance must be valid in France and a copy must be handed over if applicable.

8. Championship Regulations

The championship will be governed by the relevant CISM Regulations (Edition July 2017) the CISM Cycling Regulations (Edition 2020) and the current UCI Regulations.

9. Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.

The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).

In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.

10. Dress Code

Class A Uniform or the applicable Service Uniform is mandatory for the Opening and Closing ceremony.

11. Customs and Visa procedures

For information regarding passport and visas for entry into France, please contact the French embassy in your country or the respective embassy representing your country in France.

Make sure that you apply for your visa in time!

12. Weather conditions and additional information

1. The temperature in August in France is between 20°C – 35°C.
Average temperature is about 28° C. The probability of rain is at 60%.
2. The currency used in France is the EURO.
3. For each team a container for bikes and equipment will be made available.
