## 2. Regulations

The competition will be carried out according to the CISM Modern Pentathlon Regulation (Edition 2020)

- Swimming: 50m swimming pool / 8 lanes
- Fencing (Ranking Round) - 10 pistes
- Fencing (Bonus Round) - 1 show pistes
- Laser Run:
  - shooting range (service: Pentashot): 36+2 precision laser targetsrunning course: 800m, country loop, grass/gravel

### D. Access to the Location of the Championships

Travel cost to and from the host country is the responsibility of the participating country. City of Drzonkow is located in the south - west part of Poland. Participants can arrive straight to location by car to the address : 66-004 Zielona Gora , ul. Drzonkow - Olimpijska 20. The organizer will ensure the transportation from the point of arrival/departure in the host country to the place of stay and the transport during the competitions as well.

The closest POA :

- Poznan Lawica Airport 140 km.
- Zielona Gora Airport 38 km.
- Zielona Gora Bus/Train station 8 km

### E. Conditions of Stay

During their stay the missions are guests of the Polish Armed Forces. Suitable board, lodging and local transportation during the competition will be provided by the organizer. Extra expenses such as fees for telephone calls, laundry services, additional drinks etc. must be paid by the consumer. Any costs associated with the stay of missions before 30<sup>th</sup> August or after 06<sup>th</sup> of September must be paid by the respective missions. Additional personnel will not be accepted without an official written permission of the organizer. Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of the Polish Armed Forces. The Polish Armed Forces will provide medical support for all scheduled competitions. The Polish Armed Forces will not be responsible for any advanced medical expenses, hospital stays, surgical procedures, and/or other medical care beyond first aid. All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage. Special medical treatment is under the responsibility of the participating nations.

### F. Regulation of the Championships

- Fencing (Ranking Round) - 10 pistes
- Fencing (Bonus Round) - 1 show pistes
- Laser Run:
  - shooting range (service: Pentashot): 36+2 precision laser targets

## G. Anti-doping

1. Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
2. The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).
3. In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission for analysis and further approval.

## H. Uniforms

The participating missions are obliged to wear uniform during their stay on the official scheduled events such as opening and closing ceremony (no uniform, no ceremony). The required dress uniforms should be adapted to late summer weather conditions.

Sport attire marked with a country name may be worn outside the ceremonial events.

The delegations are requested to bring the national flag. Chiefs of delegation are requested to check and confirm if their respective national anthem is available on the CISM Extranet (<http://members.milспорт.one/officialdocuments/protocol-events-guidelines>), please send confirmation that the anthem is up to date and can be used in sports competitions.

## J. Weather Conditions

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Zielona Gora in September is 10.0°C (50°F). The amount of rain in September is normal with an average of 49mm (1.9in). This month generally has very pleasant temperatures. The average maximum temperature lies around 18.0°C (64.4°F).
