A. Right to participate in the 23rd CISM World Military Triathlon Championship, Spain 2022.

Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the the 23rd CISM World Military Triathlon Championship, Spain 2022.

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the final entry deadline. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to participate in the event.

According to CISM regulations, art. 7.23, all participants must have military status, Except ParaSport athletes, who follow their own regulations regarding the participation of athletes being active duty or not. ParaSport athletes are not taken into account in the total number of components of the mission.

D. Access to the Location of the Competition.

- The travel cost to the host country and respective return will be the responsibility of the participating country.
- The organizer will ensure the transportation from the place of arrival in the host country to the place of stay.
- The points of arrival are:
 - Alicante international Airport.
 - Murcia Int. Airport.

The organizer will also provide local transportation from the provided accommodations to the event site in Águilas, Murcia.

E. Conditions of Stay

- During the stay from 07th to 11th JUNE, in Águilas, Murcia, the participants will be guests by Spanish Armed Forces; boarding, lodging and all local transportation arrangements to commence the championship schedule with this period will be at the expense of the organizer.
- Extra expenses (telephone, cocktails, Laundry etc.), as well as cost of travel to and from Alicante or Murcia, Spain, are to be paid by the participants. Any cost before the due arrival date or after departure date including additional person's expenses must be covered by the participants.
- Additional people will not be accepted without official written permission of the Organizers.
- The organizer will take care of medical support (first aid) and emergency treatment only during the championship. In case of additional treatment, hospitalization and or routine medical care, participating nations will be responsible for the payment thereof.

F. Regulations of the Championship.

- CISM Regulations (Edition November 2020)
- The Triathlon Championship will be governed by the ITU regulations. ITU Competition Rules (approved by the ITU Executive Board, in November 2018)



According with the CISM Triathlon Regulations and ITU regulations, **drafting will be allowed** in the **Standard Distance** triathlon and in the **Team Relay** competition.

G. Anti-doping

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).

CISM Anti-Doping Symbol



- In cases where an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS no later than 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission for analysis and approval.
- Below are the Organizations Accredited by WADA to carry out the tests during the Championship:
 - Sample Collection Authority (SCA): ESP-NADO - Spain National Anti-Doping Agency (AEPSAD) (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/code-signatories>)
 - Accredited Laboratory: Madrid Anti-Doping Laboratory - Madrid, SPAIN (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/what-we-do/science-medical/laboratories/accredited-laboratories>)

H. Uniforms.

- Uniforms are mandatory. Service uniform (summer short sleeve) is required for the opening and closing ceremonies and for other official events.
- We kindly request that delegations will bring one (1) national flag. In addition, the Chief of delegation is responsible for checking if their respective national anthem is available on the CISM Extranet (<http://members.milспорт.one/officialdocuments/protocol-events-guidelines>), and if it is up to date and can be used in sports competitions.

I. Customs and Visa Procedures.

- The participating nations are responsible for acquiring the necessary custom documents upon arrival at Alicante or Murcia Airport. For information on immigration and VISA requirements, please contact the nearest Spanish Embassy of serving your nation.

J. Weather Conditions

Average temperatures for the period of the championship is 25°C/77°F.

Average temperatures of the sea for the period of the championship is 22°C/71,7°F



There are currently no weather conditions.

K. Registration Deadlines.

Preliminary Agreement is attached as Annex 1 and must be returned **NLT 1st April 2021**. Final Entry is attached as Annexes 2a, 2b and 3 and must be returned **NLT 1st May 2021**.

The Organizing Nation shall not have any obligation towards member nations which have not provide the official final entry within the deadline set in the invitation file (Article 8.3, item 4, CISM Regulations).

The participating nation should provide both valid phone and fax numbers in the final agreement form, as well as their email address in case the organizing committee needs to additional information.

L. COVID Restrictions and prevention.

Please note that the World Military Championship will be organized following the World Triathlon COVID 19 Guidelines, as well as the Spanish and Murcia regulations from the Spanish health authorities.

The following guidelines have been issued by CISM Spain using the collective feedback of different stakeholders in the sport of triathlon and have been reviewed by the World Triathlon Technical Committee. The guidelines will be updated continuously according to the latest information from the World Health Organization and the research/ publications that are released on this topic.

The event will look different from what we are all used to. Some of the measures will have an impact on how the event looks like. Here are the measures that will be in affect:

- Pre-travel Health Checks for all personal Staff will be held to ensure exclusion of those with potential additional risks.
- PCR test or vaccination certificate could be requested by regional authorities on the arrival to Spain. A Pre-event medical Test (Antigen) for COVID 19 will be mandatory. It will be done by CISM Spain medical service. In case a positive Test, the athlete will not be allowed to participate in WMC. CISM Spain will send a COVID report one week before PA and FE expiring dates.
- Temperature checks will be required to access the venue and access will not be allowed to anyone with high temperature, or symptoms of COVID.
- Face mask is mandatory in enclosed areas.
- CISM Spain will not facilitate any interviews with athletes before or after the event, so that athletes don't have to be in close contact with any external media personnel. Athletes can participate it at their discretion, preferably in open air spaces.
- Due to COVID restrictions, Opening and Closing Ceremonies may be reduced to the minimum required national representatives.
- In case of symptoms suggestive of acute respiratory illness before, during or after travel, the athletes are encouraged to seek medical attention and share travel history with CISM Spain.

- Individual Responsibility:
 - Participants should aim to keep at least two meters distance from other people.
 - Frequent hand washing by participants using soap and hot water or alcohol-based (at least 65-70%) hand rub for 20 seconds.
 - Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
 - Avoid steam rooms or sauna.
 - Athletes racing in a triathlon event must monitor their health status continuously (including taking their temperature and monitoring for any symptoms) from 14 days before and during the event.
