Only CISM active member nations have the right to participate in the 1st CISM Military Basketball 3x3 Challenge.

An inactive nation, intending to take part in the event must pay its annual fee before the deadline established by the Organizing Committee of the world military championships for sending the final entry. If it is not done, the delegation will not be able to take part in the event.

As of now, this allows for up to two (2) men's 3x3 teams and one (1) women's 3x3 team per country. Each team is allowed up to 4 players. This is subject to change based on interested countries.

The Competition is limited to military personal on active duty (see CISM Regulations, Art. 7.23).

3. TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM THE COMPETITION VENUE

The cost of travel to and from Germany will be the responsibility of the participating country. The organizer will ensure the transportation from the mentioned places of arrival/departure



in Germany to the designated competition and will also provide transport during the conduct of the event.

5. CONDITIONS OF STAY

During their stay the missions are guests of the German Federal Armed Forces. Suitable board, lodging, and local transportation during the competition will be provided by the organizer.

The consumer must pay extra expenses such as fees for telephone calls, laundry services, additional drinks etc. Any costs associated with the stay of missions before 03rd July 2022 or after 10th July 2022 must be paid by the respective missions.

Additional personnel will not be accepted without an official written permission of the organizer.

The cost of travel to the point of arrival and from the point of departure in Germany is solely the responsibility of the participating nation. Transportation from the points of arrival in Germany (Warendorf-Region) and return will be provided by the organizer.

Medical emergencies (first aid) will be the responsibility of the German Federal Armed Forces. The German Federal Armed Forces will provide medical support for all scheduled competitions. The German Federal Armed Forces will not be responsible for any advanced



medical expenses, including hospital stays, surgical procedures, and/or other medical care beyond first aid.

All participants must travel with their own inherent medical coverage. Special medical treatment is under the responsibility of the participating nations.

6. CUSTOMS AND VISA PROCEDURES

Information concerning passports, visas and vaccinations can be obtained from the German Embassy in your country (Invitation is present at German Embassy).

7. REGULATIONS

The competition will be organized in accordance with the most recent regulations of the Official FIBA 3x3 Basketball Rules April 2020 and CISM Regulations as amended and current as of January 2022. Possible exceptions of the regulations and modifications will be forwarded to all participating nations.

8. UNIFORMS

- Formal Military uniforms with jacket and tie (Class A) are mandatory for official ceremonies, especially for opening and closing ceremony of the Championships.
- Request the participants' flag and that the Chief of delegation to check if their respective national anthem, available on the CISM Extranet (<http://members.milспорт.one/officialdocuments/protocol-events-guidelines>), is up to date and can be used in sports competitions.

9. ANTI DOPING

- Anti-Doping tests will be conducted in accordance with the **CISM Anti-Doping Symbol** CISM Regulations – Chapter IX, CISM Anti-Doping Rules, the concerned CISM Sports Regulations, the concerned International Federation Rules, and all WADA rules, mainly the World Anti-Doping Code, and the International Standard for Testing.
- The number and type of tests, as well the athletes to
- be tested shall be determined by the CISM Anti-Doping Commission. These procedures will follow the concerned CISM Test Distribution Plain (TDP).
- In case an athlete has a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), the Chief of Delegation should send this TUE to the CISM GS until 30 days before the Opening Ceremony. This TUE will be submitted to the TUE Commission to analysis and further approval.





10. WEATHER INFORMATION

The weather for end of June and beginning of July can range from a daily high of 23° - 27° Celsius to a daily low of 17° - 24° Celsius. The possibility of sun is high and of rain is minor.

11. HYGIENICAL CONCEPT – COVID 19 PANDEMIC

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the high number of support personnel and international participants from many countries the event will be limited to persons who are either vaccinated against or have fully recovered from the coronavirus.

Furthermore, the organizers will introduce a hygienical concept for the whole tournament which will be enforced by a Medical Board before and during the tournament. This concept will be sent to all participating nations.
