## C. General Information

### a. Composition of the Mission

The Competition is limited to cadet students<sup>1</sup> in age between 14-18 years, and in possession of valid student ID card.

### b. Access to the Location of the Competition.

The location of the competition is the Hungarian Defence Forces Military Recreation, Conference and Training Centre (HDF MRCTC) in Balatonakarattya. Travel expenses, to and from Hungary, will be the responsibility of the participating country. The organizing committee will provide round-trip transportation from the place of arrival to the place of stay in Hungary and the transport during the competition.

### **c. Conditions of Stay**

- a. Board and lodging shall be provided for all participants, as well as transport from the airport to the centre and for all ICC related events at the expense of the organizer.
- b. The Chief of Mission is responsible to avoid any act by any member of the Mission, which causes damage for the organizer or for any participant. In case of damage, the Chief of Mission has to recover it.





- c. Participants are required to pay extra expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, travel to non-event related locations (taxi) and additional food and beverages.
- d. Any cost before the foreseen arrival date and/or after the departure date must be covered by the participants.
- e. Nations arriving before 11 April 2022 and departing after 14 April 2022 will be responsible for all expenses during the period outside the official competition dates.
- f. In accordance with the Statues and traditions of sport, any political or and religious action during the competition, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, clothing, brochures, reviews etc., is strictly forbidden. Any contravention will result in immediate exclusion and deportation of such nation.
- g. Possessing or consuming any kind of alcohol, tobacco or narcotic product by a person under 18 age is strictly forbidden.
- h. Additional persons will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizers. The costs for board and lodging are at their own expense.
- i. The Organizers will provide medical assistance to the participants for the duration of the event which includes first aid and transportation to the designated hospital. However, the Organizers are NOT responsible for:
  - Hospitalizations;
  - Surgical operations or other special treatments;
  - Repatriation in case of death;
  - Other expenses incurred due to illness and/or accident such as compensation for loss of income, etc.
- j. To cover the above-mentioned risks, participants must arrange sufficient insurance in their home countries and this insurance must be valid in Hungary. A copy of the insurance certificate and policy must be provided to the Organizers by the time of final entry.
- k. In Hungary the tap water is safe to drink.
- l. Menus are widely varied. **Please indicate diet and religion-related requirements on the final entry (annex 2b).**

## d. Regulations of the Competition.

### OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official communication language of the event is English. The organiser won't arrange interpreter for the participants. Every Mission has to have at least one member, who can communicate in English.

### ACCREDITATION

The appointed Chief of Mission sends the Preliminary Agreement and the Final Entry form to the organiser, on time. The organiser sends back the Official Invitation Letter ASAP.

Every member of the Mission will get a personal accreditation card with photo, and has to wear it during the hole event.





## PHOTO

The Chief of Mission send a portrait photo about each member of the Mission to the organiser by the time of Final Entry (not later than 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022).

## TEAM COMPOSITION

Each team consists of four athletes with the age limit of 14-18 years (the combination of male and female athletes is optional), and with valid student ID card.

## RESULTS

The competition is a team competition (The athletes won't be awarded individually).

After the start the team moves and competes together following the places of the events in the right order, and fulfilling the tasks in a shortest time and the highest success. The team will be ranked after every event.

The winner will be decided on the score of the total ranked points. (The detailed rules will be delivered for the chief of mission until 31<sup>th</sup> of March.)

## EVENTS (not in competition order)

### 1. Laser Run Shooting (LRS)

Team members have to shoot with laser rifle at the biathlon target while they are accomplishing a running track. The missed target will be punished with extra run. The execution time are measured.

### 2. Labyrinth Matrix Run (LMR)

Team members have to run in an artificial labyrinth where they have to reach 10 control points in the right order marked the map. The number of missed points and the performed time will be measured. The team members will start the course at same time. The individual results will be added together and will result the accomplished time of LMR based on mm:ss,00.

SPORTIDENT timekeeping system will be used.

### 3. First Aid

Practical exercise, where the team have to provide a first aid care (based on combat life saver skills) in a given situation. The detailed rules will include the exact description of the situation. The accuracy and the execution time count.

### 4. Hand Grenade Throwing (HGT)

By the following the marked track with light obstacles the team members have to throw hand grenades from different positions (laying, kneeling, standing) into target on different distances. Missing the target, the athlete has to repeat to throw a grenade. The event will be executed as a relay run. The execution time will be measured.

### 5. Distance Estimation

The team have to estimate distances and sizes of objects. The accuracy will be counted.

### 6. Obstacle Course

Artificial obstacle course. The time will be measured based on mm:ss,00.

### 7. Relay Run with rifle

The team members have to complete an assigned track (up to 500m) with rifle (imitation rifle). The total time of the team will be measured.

## AWARDS

All participants will receive a “Certificate of Participation” and “Medal of Participation”. The 1-3<sup>rd</sup> place will be awarded with special medal, cup and personal gifts provided by the sponsors of the ICC.

## e. Dress code

### COMPETITION

Athletes: Official t-shirt, shirt and shoes representing the home country. During the obstacle course event, the clothes will be wet. **Reserve clothes are recommended!** Should be clean, conceived and put on in a way not to offend. Using the shoes and boots with built-in carbide stud traction is forbidden. The national t-shirt can be replaced with the official t-shirt provided by the organizers. Chief of Mission: Casual.

### OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY (AND TECHNICAL MEETING)

For athletes: Training suits uniform representing the home country.  
For the Chief of Mission: Formal.

### WELCOME DRINK

Casual.

## f. Customs and Visa Procedures

For information regarding passport and visas for entry into Hungary, please contact The Hungarian embassy in your country or the respective embassy serving your country in Hungary. Make sure, that you apply for your visa in time!  
The organizer will send an official invitation letter after sending back the ANNEXE 1.

## g. Pandemic information

The actual pandemic procedure and safety precautions during the event will be defined about the actual national regulation rules.  
If previously the pandemic situation will be serious, the organiser has the right to postpone or cancel the event.

## h. Weather Conditions

The temperature in April in Hungary is between 5-15°C. Average temperature is about 10°C. The probability of rain, shower and short storms with thundering is at 40%.

## FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION

### 2<sup>nd</sup> International Cadet Cup

To be given over arriving to Balatonakarattya:

NATION :

The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read this **Invitation Form** and moreover understood the following prescriptions:

#### A. PARTICIPATION - STUDENT STATUS

- a. Only personnel on active study in Secondary School may take part in the competition as an athlete. The athletes have to be in the age between 14 and 18 years.
- b. All cadet participants in the ICC event shall be in possession of proper documentation which signifies active student status in a school of the participating country. The documentation can be:
  - A valid student identity card for those athletes who are authorized to present their student identity cards abroad.
  - A form of verification (in English) of student status accompanied by a passport.
- c. **By signing the final entry, the Chief of Mission confirms the student status of the participating athletes.** If there are last minute changes in the participation of the athletes, the verification file may be signed by the Chief of Mission.

**If one of these documents is not available, participation is refused.**

#### B. CHIEF OF MISSION

- a. The Chief of Mission is appointed by the participating country. The Chief of Mission has to keep in touch with the organizer before and during the hole event.
- b. Missions must not only participate or be present at sport events, they are also required to participate cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.

#### C. CONDUCT OF A MISSION

- a. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behaviour of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by the organizers of the cup. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances





of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by the organiser and may result in the disqualification of the participating athletes or teams.

- b. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behaviour and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the sport spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition.

## **D. RULES OF STAY**

### **a. General**

1. The Chiefs of Mission are responsible for the discipline of their mission. The missions fall under the jurisdiction of the organizing nation. During events, all athletes present on the playing fields are equal in front of the jury, the referees and to themselves. No one may use his rank/position to impose his views on sports matters.
2. The presentation of medals takes place, in principle, during the closing ceremony. The presentation of medals may be done in sports uniform. Sports uniforms shall respect the corresponding national criteria (training suit, sports shoes, etc.) Displaying the national flag on the podium by the recipient (athlete or team) at a medal awarding ceremony is forbidden. Teams failing to respect these prescriptions shall not receive their medal(s) during the official ceremonies.

### **b. Forbidden actions**

1. In conformity with the statutes and traditions of sport, any political or religious propaganda during the event, in particular the dissemination of documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc. is strictly forbidden.

### **c. Accommodations**

1. All missions, including those of the host nation, shall be accommodated under the same conditions. The missions are expected to accept the accommodation provided by the organizing nation.
2. Any mission that does not accept the accommodations provided by the organizing nation will not be allowed to participate in the championship.
