Only military personnel in active duty in the Armed Forces are allowed to participate in the 1st Baltic Military Shooting Championship (Air Pistol).

C. BOARD AND LODGING

a) During the stay in Latvia from July 11-15, 2022, the participants will be the guests of the Latvian Armed Forces. Board and lodging will be at the expenses of the organizers, except the activities not being part of the normal program (i.e. telephone, supplementary drinks, laundry, etc.).

b) Any costs before July 11 and after July 15 must be paid by the respective mission. Additional persons will not be accepted by the organization without explicit written requested by the Chief of the concerned country and under condition of the written agreement from the Chief of the Latvian Delegation.

c) The Organizing Committee provides medical assistance to the mission members including first aid and transport to hospital during the competition.

d) The organizing Committee is not responsible for:

- Hospitalization beyond July 15, 2022;
- Surgical operations or other special treatments;
- Complicated return transport due to illness/accident;
- Other expenses because of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income etc.

To cover the above-mentioned risk participants must arrange sufficient insurance in their home countries.
