### 3. Composition of the Mission

Only military personnel in active duty may participate in the competitions (see CISM Regulations, art. 7.21).

### 4. Access to the Location of the Competition

All participants arriving to Antalya will be welcomed at the Antalya International Airport or the Antalya Bus Station by the organizer country and transported to the Karpuzkaldıran Military Camping Center.

Participants arriving by own car can drive directly to "Karpuzkaldıran Military Camping Center". Organizer can not provide transportation from any other points of arrival. The cost of travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating country.

## 5. Conditions of Stay

During their stay in Türkiye, the missions will be the guests of the Turkish Armed Forces from  $25^{th} - 31^{st}$  October 2023. Full board (extra expenses including, telephone, laundry and drinks must be paid by the consumers) and lodging are at the expense of the organizer. Accommodation will be provided at Karpuzkaldıran Military Camping Center.

Any cost before the foreseen arrival date and/or after the departure date must be covered by the participants.

First aid for the participants will be provided by the organizer. Organizer country is NOT responsible for: hospitalizations, surgical operations and any other special treatments, repatriation in case of decease by illness or accident, other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensations, loss of income etc.

### 6. Regulations of the Championship

- Competitions will be conducted on the basis of Regulations of the IOF and CISM Sports Regulations (Orienteering-2020, 2.1.6)
- Each nation can participate the competition with five (5) male and three (3) female athletes. Individual medals will be given to three (3) best athletes for each competition.
- For the team ranking; the scores of three (3) best male athletes and two (2) best female athletes competing on behalf of each country will be included in the scoring. Team Cups will be given separately for men and women in the team ranking. General (mixed) classification will not be applied for the team ranking.

#### 7. Uniforms

Uniforms are mandatory for the closing and medal ceremony.

#### 9. Weather Conditions

#### 12. Currency

- The currency in Türkiye is Turkish Liras. Currency exchange is available at the airport and local banks. It is also possible to withdraw cash from an automated cash point.
- In Karpuzkaldıran Military Camping Center, only debit and credit cards are accepted. So if you want use your debit/credit cards in Karpuzkaldıran Military Camping Center, it is required to open them international roaming.

#### 13. Eligibility

Competitors must be active duty military personnel in their respective countries, with valid military identity cards, in accordance with CISM Policy Manual art. 3.19.

#### 14. Traveling Expenses

The cost of travel to go and to come back from the point of arrival/departure will be the responsibility of the participating nation. Local transportations during the championship will be at the expense of the organizer.

### 15. National Anthems and Flags

ANNEX 2c

FINAL ENTRY - COMMITMENT BY THE CHIEF OF MISSION
NATION:
The undersigned, Chief of Mission declare that he has read the Article 3.28. of the CISM Policy Manual and moreover understood the following prescriptions:
A. Chief of Mission
1. Chiefs of Mission shall be familiar with CISM regulations.
2. Missions must not only participate or be present at sports events, they are also required to participate in information conferences on CISM, study days, commemorative and cultural events and ceremonies organized by the host nation.
B. Conduct of a mission
1. The Chief of Mission is responsible for the behavior of his team in sports and general discipline. He shall ensure that members of his mission respect the rules and directives prescribed by CISM and organizers of the championship. The respect of schedules is particularly important as they form the basis for the effective conduct of competitions and ceremonies. Instances of indiscipline or poor sportsmanship will be handled by Championship officials and may result in the disqualification of individual athletes or teams.
2. The Chief of Mission shall also enforce the rules concerning behavior and dress during the ceremonies. He plays an important role in promoting the CISM spirit among his mission, a spirit represented by friendly attitude towards other missions, courtesy towards organizers and fair-play in competition. The mission, who does not wear military uniforms during the closing and medal ceremony of a Championship, will not be authorised to take part in the Championship. The Official CISM Representative will communicate this decision.
3. In conformity with the Statutes and traditions of CISM, any political or religious action during a CISM event, in particular the dissemination of propaganda documents, pictures, brochures, reviews, etc, is strictly forbidden. Any contravention shall result in the exclusion of the mission from further competition.
4. The athletes agree notably to; behave accordingly their situation as militaries and refrain from doping as defined by the WADA Doping Control Regulations.
