All events and sessions of the 79th General Assembly and Congress will take place at the Johari Rotana Hotel. **The CISM authorities, the CISM General Secretariat and the first 260 people will be accommodated at**

the Johari Rotana Hotel. Other participants (60 singles) will be accommodated at the Dar es Salaam Serena Hotel which is located 2 km away from the Johari Rotana Hotel. Transport to and from the two locations will be provided to those who will be reserved at Dar es Salaam Serena Hotel daily.

Hotel reservations will require credit card details or a deposit to guarantee the booking. **Rooms will be assigned on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVED basis.** Visa and Master Card Credit Cards are accepted. Payment in cash upon arrival is also acceptable. Any extra expenses will be charged to guests with payments expected before check-out.

The arrival and departure dates falling 2 days before or after the mentioned checking-in dates will be subject to the same rates and availability.

Bookings should be re-confirmed not later than 35 days prior to the date of arrival and the reservation may not be re-assigned without consent of the Hotels. To avoid the penalty charge please note that cancellations must be done 2 weeks before the arrival date.

Due to the 'first come first served' rule in both hotels, the Tanzania CISM Delegation shall coordinate the distribution of delegates in each hotel.


4. FACILITIES

Convention Center:


Johari Rotana Hotel offers appropriate facilities and meeting rooms, required to successfully host CISM General Assembly and Congress.

The convention center offers the possibility to organize all the CISM meetings inside the Hotel area.

Internet Access:

5. COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION & VERIFICATION OF THE CREDENTIALS OF THE DELEGATES

Each Delegation shall comprise of one Chief of Delegation and a maximum of two Delegates for a total of three members.

Additional members (BOD members, Commission Members, PCSC, etc.) can be registered too.

6. SPOUSE PROGRAM

Accompanying people are most welcome and a special program will be organized for them.

7. CULTURAL DAY

The Tanzanian delegation will organize visits to cultural sites. The event schedule is subject to change depending on the number of participants and the local conditions. For planning purposes, you will be kindly requested to indicate your participation in this cultural activity.

8. WEATHER CONDITION

The weather in Dar Es Salaam in May is hot. The average temperatures are between 23°C and 29°C, so drinking water regularly is advisable.

9. TRANSPORTATION

The CISM Delegations are responsible for their transport to and from the entry point in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.

CISM Delegations shall arrive at the Julius Nyerere International Airport (DAR ES SALAAM), be met by the host site coordinators and be transported to the site of the accommodations.

The Tanzanian Delegation to CISM will provide all transportation necessary for all official events during the General Assembly & Congress.

10. VISA

- i. There are two options to obtain a Tanzania Visa. These are **Online Visa Platform** and **On-Arrival Visa Platform**. However, it is recommended to use **Online Visa platform**;
- ii. Visa applicants are advised to make their applications through the Official Tanzania Immigration website (www.immigration.go.tz) **ONLY** and Not through any other links;
- iii. Applicants must ensure that their passports have a validity of at least six months and at least one unused visa page before submitting their application;
- iv. The Visa applications will be processed within ten days, therefore applicants are strongly advised to observe the stipulated time frame while making their applications;
- v. After making payments, applicants are required to wait for approval of their Visa before they start their journey, even if the stipulated time frame expires;
- vi. Approval notifications will be sent to the applicant's e-mails. If for any reason, the applicant does not receive Visa notification within the specified time, it is advised to download the Visa Grant Notice through the following link: https://eservices.immigration.go.tz/visa/checkapplicationstatus;
- vii. Applicants whose nationals fall under **Referral Visa category** are not eligible for on arrival Visa platform. **They must apply Online**. Before getting approval for their Visa, they are not advised to pay for flight tickets or hotel accommodation. They may only make a flight booking or make hotel reservations; payments should only be done after they get approval for their Visa. **Also, such applicants are advised to apply at least two months before sending their Final Entry.**
- viii. The list of countries which fall under Referred Visa may change at any time; therefore, applicants are advised to review this list on our website from time to time.

ix. TYPES OF VISA

ORDINARY VISA (SINGLE ENTRY VISA) is the type of visa to be applied for all delegates except the following:-

- 1. USA nationals who are required to apply for MULTIPLE VISA.
- 2. Those holding diplomatic passports who can apply for a **GRATIS VISA**.
- 3. Countries which their nationals cannot obtain Visa on arrival are required to apply for **Referral Visa Category.**

x. PROCEDURE FOR REFERRAL VISA CATEGORY

Applicants from this category MUST submit their Visa applications Online and should wait until their applications are approved before starting their journey. These applicants are further advised to submit their applications at least 1 month before their travel date. Having an invitation letter or a request letter for visa from the Host is an added credibility of their application. This letter, if available MUST be uploaded in the Online Visa Application and NOT to be sent by email as a separate document. The letter may be uploaded separately or merged with the Itinerary of the Trip and uploaded in the Return ticket field. If the Visa is approved, the holder MUST come with the actual return ticket upon arrival.

xi. VISA APPLICATION FOR REFERRAL CASES

Applicants who fall under Referral Visa category MUST apply for their Visa Online; they cannot obtain Visa on arrival. Their Visa process may take longer time than other Visa applicants. They are advised to submit their applications at least two months in advance before their travel date. Further, they are advised to attach an introduction letter and any other document of their host (whether an individual or company) while applying If applicable. If they come for tourism purpose, it is recommended to obtain a covering letter from a registered credible company and it must be uploaded online along with other relevant documents for consideration. The introduction/covering letter may be attached in any attachment field along with other documents as a single PDF file,

After submission of application, applicants are advised not to start their journey until they get confirmation that their Visa are approved. They are further advised not to make payments for any booking or reservations made.

11. MEDICAL CARE

The Organizing Committee will bear all necessary emergency (first aid) hospital/medical center care expenses. All other expenses, such as hospitalizations, surgical operations and any other special treatments, repatriation in case of disease by illness or accident, and other expenses on account of illness/accident such as compensation loss of income or non-emergency dental/medical care will be charged to the user themselves. If for any reason the injured participant's delegation refuses the medical arrangements proposed by the Organizing committee the costs of hospitalization or treatment at another facility will be the responsibility of the delegation.

12. YELLOW FEVER ENTRY REQUIREMENTS IN TANZANIA

In order to conform to the International Health Regulations, 2005 requirements and safeguard public health security in Tanzania:

- i. Yellow fever vaccination is mandatory for travellers arriving from countries with a risk of Yellow fever transmission (Yellow Fever Endemic Countries). This condition also applies to travellers subjected to long flight connections (transit) in those countries for twelve hours (12hrs) or more.
- ii. Yellow fever vaccine is given as a single dose and should be administered ten (10) days before travel to Tanzania. A single dose is capable of providing life protection against the Yellow fever virus.
- iii. Travelers with medical reasons approved by an authorized Medical Officer shall submit medical proof upon arrival in Tanzania.

- iv. Exempted people due to medical reasons and age (above 60 and below 1 year) should seek medical attention in case of fever, headache, muscle and joint aches while in Tanzania.
- v. Failure to produce a valid certificate against Yellow fever to those eligible may be denied entry or vaccinated upon arrival and kept under close public health observation for not more than 10 days.
- vi. Travelers coming from countries which are not in the below list of countries with risk of Yellow fever transmission and not transited into those countries 12 hours and above will not be subjected to Yellow fever vaccination at points of entry upon arrival.

13. INSURANCE

The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any claim for loss, injury or damage arising from the holding of the 79th CISM General Assembly and Congress.

Points related to medical coverage:

- for the organizing country: obligation to give first aid and to take care of the hospital. The Organizing Committee can practice non-invasive medicine.
- for the guest nation: obligation to take out insurance for all the care that can be given to the persons in the delegation.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for post-injury medical follow-up, nor any medical or psychological consequences resulting from the injury.

The Missions must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel, accidents and health risks as they are not under the responsibility of the Organizing Committee nor CISM.

14. SECURITY MEASURES

All participating delegations and national staff will be registered and will receive the appropriate credentials to access the venues, lodgings and all sites that they require. The use of accreditation will provide the necessary control and security measures ensuring the smooth flow of personnel while restricting access of non-authorized persons, providing a safe environment for all.

15. PLASTIC BAN IN TANZANIA

The new law banning plastic bags came into force on June 1, 2019. The ban applies to all types of plastic bags, regardless of their thickness (including cling film or plastic wrap) and implies fines. The ban does not apply to medicines, items in plastic packaging that preserves their quality and zippered bags for hygiene kits or documents (on condition that they are not thrown away on the territory of Tanzania).

To avoid problems when crossing the Tanzanian border, we ask that you check your luggage for plastic bags and do not wrap anything in plastic wrap. The same applies to hand luggage. It is advisable to pack your belongings in paper or cloth bags. Alternatively, you can use waterproof nylon bags to protect your luggage from moisture.

16. PRIVATE TOURISM

Pre and post event private tourism will be advised by the local organizing committee. Special local tourism agencies are designated with special offers/packages to those interested in unforgettable experiences/safaris in the Land of Kilimanjaro, Zanzibar and the Serengeti.

17. REGISTRATION

All CISM authorities, delegates and spouses must complete the Final Entry and send it to the Organizing Committee with color photos in good quality (35mm*45mm min size in the format of JPG, with a resolution rate no less than 300dpi) before 1st March 2024 for accreditation.
