NOTE:

This regional championship cycling can host a maximum quantity of 50 team members all together. First 50 will be determined by received date of the PA.

According to the CISM Regulations chapter VII art.7.22. only military personnel in active duty and in possession of a valid military ID card may participate in the competition.

Additional visitors will not be accepted without official written permission of the organizing committee. The costs for board and lodging are at their own expenses.

4. Access to the location of the competition

The competition will take place at two different locations in the Netherlands. The road race will take place at cycling centre Nedereindseberg, Utrecht.

MTB and time trial at Bernhard barracks "de Vlasakkers" Amersfoort.

All participants will stay in the barracks of Stroe. Teams come (preferably) with own transportation to Stroe Barracks or shall arrive at Schiphol Amsterdam International Airport or Eindhoven Airport. Delegations will be met at the main gate of the Stroe barracks or airports by a host nation coordinator / liaison officer and will be transported to the lodging accommodation in Stroe.

- a. The costs and organization of the travel to and from the host country will be the responsibility of the participating nations.
- b. The organizer will ensure all transportation in the host country from the moment of arrival till the moment of departure.

5. Conditions of stay

During their stay in The Netherlands the missions will be guests of The Netherlands Armed Forces from 2 – 6 September 2024.

The following conditions are applicable:

- a. Board and lodging will be provided for all participants, as well as transport for and to all tournament and CISM related events.
- b. Participants will be required to pay extra expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, additional food and beverages.
- c. It is not possible to make use of the barracks and facilities outside the official competition dates.

6. Food and beverage

The use of bottled water is not necessary. Tap water is safe to drink. Menus are widely varied.

Please indicate diet and religion-related requirements on the final agreement (annex 2a).

7. Medical support

The Netherlands will take care of medical support (first aid) on site. Further costs for medical support are at the expense of the participants. Participants' health insurance must be valid in The Netherlands and a copy must be handed over if applicable.

8. Regulations of the championship

The championship will be conducted in accordance with the CISM Cycling Regulations (Edition 2021)

Medals will be awarded for male and female categories. The championship will be an all-round competition. The first place will be for the competitor with the most amount of points added up of the three competition components. In case of equal points at the end the time trial results will be decisive.

9. Uniforms and dress code

No service uniforms are required. All dining moments and award ceremonies are done in country tracksuit.

10. Customs and visa procedures

For information regarding passport and visas for entry into The Netherlands, please contact The Netherlands embassy in your country or the respective embassy serving your country in The Netherlands.

Make sure, that you apply for your visa in time!

11. Weather conditions and additional information

The weather for September in The Netherlands is fairly unpredictable and could vary from very nice sunny weather till days filled with rain showers.

Average daily temperature: 22° C.

The currency used in The Netherlands is the EURO.
